




## Why will Eden Park High School be opening at The Ravensbourne School?

Whilst we are waiting for the permanent site on Balmoral Avenue to be built, Eden Park High School will have temporary accommodation at The Ravensbourne School. The temporary accommodation will be situated on the top field of The Ravensbourne School site, it will be a modular build and hold twelve classrooms. Our students will be registered in these rooms and may have some of their lessons there, however the majority of their schooling will be in the specialist classrooms within the main building.

- Excellent secondary school facilities; The Ravensbourne School site is historic and has an inspirational learning environment. The amenities are state-of-the-art and whilst on this site the students from Eden Park High School will be able to take advantage of the fully equipped ICT rooms, Science laboratories, Sports facilities, dance / drama / music rooms and so forth.
- The extended school day can run successfully; Eden Park High School will benefit from the wide range of performing arts, sports and media arts facilities so that the enrichment programme can be provided to an outstanding quality.
- Normal transition to secondary school; students from Eden Park High School will be part of an extended school community where they will observe outstanding behaviour from upper years, benefit from having older students mentor and coach them, move around a secondary school building to reach specialist teaching rooms just as they would if they were on their permanent site.
- Experienced and exceptional teaching staff; the two schools will have the same staff members working between them. This means that the ethos and values of "to be the best you can be" will be consistent and students at both schools are benefitting from highly qualified and well trained teachers.

Each school will have its own identity in terms of a separate leadership team, year leader, tutors and uniform. The overall concept of opening on the site of The Ravensbourne School is "a school within a school".
