Subject: Music

Overview

In year 7 and 8, students will be taught two schemes of work over a termly rotation. Through these two schemes of learning, students will begin to develop basic vocal and instrumental skills to apply to performance when working in multi-instrument ensembles. The schemes of learning and skills learned will be the basis to build on through the rest of KS3 and also develop fluidly into skills required for KS4.
