ACTIVE CITIZENSHIP AWARD



SESSION DESCRIPTION

Active citizenship is a process to involve pupils in learning how to take part in democracy and use their Citizenship knowledge, skills and understanding to work together in trying to make a positive difference in the world around them.



The awards are based around three areas: learning, school culture and community. To achieve an award, pupils design, develop, undertake and report on an active citizenship project within one of these areas – the project can be on any issue that they care strongly about and want to challenge, change or improve.

ARTS AWARD (ART)



SESSION DESCRIPTION

Students experience an exciting opportunity to create, design and enter a number of live competitions. We will look at the Art World and see what current competitions are out there. Whether it is designing the logo for Google or creating a bag for the Design Museum, we will see what we can enter to help you experience the full design process from receiving a brief to meeting the deadline.



You will experience many creative techniques while competing against others to get your designs recognised and to express yourself creatively. While doing this, we will enter your creative work into the Art Award programme so that you can gain a qualification from the experience. Many of these types of competitions allows you to become involved in the community and create outcomes which all can benefit from and enjoy.

ARTS AWARD (DRAMA)



SESSION DESCRIPTION

The sessions will include a variety of Performing Arts activities surrounding Drama. Students will get the opportunity to create and perform work to their peers, gain insight into the world of theatre and how a show is made. Students can present their findings through the medium of performances and written worksheets, which can be collated as evidence toward their Arts Award.



As students progress through the Arts Award, every young person will be able to discover the enjoyment of creating and participating in arts activities & experience arts events while developing creative and communication skills that are essential for success in 21st century life. As well as this, each person can explore the work of artists and craftspeople and gain insights into the professional arts world while gaining experience and knowledge to help progress into further education and employment.

ARTS AWARD (MUSIC)



SESSION DESCRIPTION

Through participating in music enrichment students will have the opportunity to perform music and create their own music. Through the initial sessions, students will explore how music technology can be used to create music and how to play a variety of instruments.



As students' progress through the term they will specialise in a particular area they have found most interesting and develop their skills in this area. This may result in students forming a band with other students, students developing a repertoire of solo pieces on a particular instrument or creating their own music using music sequencing software.

The Award this year will allow students to specialise in classical guitar, gaining new skills and learning how to play the instrument, which can, in time, progress on to electric or bass guitar.

SPORTS LEADERSHIP AWARD



SESSION DESCRIPTION

Our Sports Leadership qualifications are our most popular qualifications. The qualifications are designed to use sport and physical activity to help young people develop and hone their leadership skills whilst helping themselves and others stay physically active.



Young people undertaking a qualification in Sports Leadership will learn and demonstrate important life skills such as effective communication and organisation whilst learning to lead basic physical activities to younger people, their peers, older generations and within the community.
