Autumn Term

Novel: In the Sea There are Crocodiles
 analysing differences between fact and fiction - choices the authro has made in telling someone else's story - impact on audience
 exploring contextual factors:
 Afghanistan (Taliban/Pashnu/Hazara); human trafficking; cultural differences; immigration
 analysing author's use of language techniques to convey narrative voice (young boy)
 Novel: Noughts & Crosses
 analysis of language to convey themes - racism; violence and conflict; love and relationships
 writing discursively: students to structure a persuasive piece responding to a contextual statement

Spring Term

Poetry: Armitage / Duffy / introduction to GCSE poetry / unseen poetry
 analysing use of language and structure to convey idea / theme / viewpoint
 Identifying and analysing writers' use of language to convey these ideas
 Looking at a range of unseen poetry and making comparisons
 Examining themes across poems and poets / analysing similarities and differences / planning how to structure a comparison essay
 Discursive writing using themes in poems to structure persuasive / commentary pieces

Summer Term

Shakespeare - Othello
 Analysing use of language to convey character of Iago - classical antagonist
 analysing use of language to convey themes: race, jealousy
 explanation of context: setting (Venice) (Cyprus), race, James I
 Discursive writing:
 structuring/use of connectives
 rehtorical devices:
 repetition/use of evidence/
 emotive language / metaphor/
 rhetorical questions
 tone of writing
